

“PCB Investigation Update”...week of July 11, 2005:

Each week we bring you the latest developments in the ongoing investigation and elimination of the PCBs found in the 10 Mile Drainage District and Lange and Revere canals.

The City is in a “holding pattern” waiting for a report on the *full* results of the geo-probe samples takes in the 10 Mile Drainage District.

Although results from a small number of samples were completed with a 7 day turn around, all tests must be validated before the EPA to make an accurate assessment of the problem.

EPA representative Jeff Kimble indicated that the invalidated results he has seen so far show no health concerns for residential back yards or tested sump pumps. The complete validated results should be available within the next two to three weeks.
