

**“PCB Investigation Update” for March 24, 2006:**

**We bring you the latest developments in the ongoing investigation and elimination of the PCBs found in the 10 Mile Drainage District and the Lange and Revere canals.**

**Christina Bush, Toxicologist for the State of Michigan Department of Community Health, issued a detailed response to community health concerns voiced at the March 1 Town Hall Meeting.**
