Boating in St. Clair Shores

Situated on the shores of Lake St. Clair, the City of St. Clair Shores owns and operates two municipal boat well harbors: Lac Sainte Clair Harbor (located on Jefferson Avenue at 11 Mile Road) and Blossom Heath Harbor (located on Jefferson just South of 10 Mile Road). Our harbors are open to both residents of the City of St. Clair Shores and non-residents.



The City also operates three boat ramps, allowing residents and their guests who do not own a well to launch their boats during the season for a small fee.

Boat Ramps

The three boat ramps operated by the City of St. Clair Shores are restricted to residents of the City and their guests, with the exception of the Nine Mile Ramp, which is open to residents of Eastpointe.

Residents possessing a park pass must pay \$10.00 per personal watercraft every time they launch. Residents may also choose to purchase a seasonal boat ramp sticker for a one-time fee of \$65.00 at the Parks and Recreation office.

Boat ramp stickers are to be placed on the port side of the boat, directly below the MC number of the boat registered with our office. Watercraft without stickers properly affixed will be refused admittance by the gate attendant.

Boat Wells

Purchase of a boat well at either of St. Clair Shores' two municipal harbors is open to both residents of the City and non-residents. Both harbors can accommodate boats up to 25 feet in length. Lac Sainte Claire Harbor can also accommodate 28—35 foot boat wells as well. Occupancy is from April 15 of each year to October 15.

Blossom Heath fees include dockage space only. Lac Sainte Claire fees include dockage space, water, electricity, family passes to the public pool, and use of a dock box.
